July 2019 Voters Meeting

Terry Koebernick made a motion to approve the June Minutes. 2nd by Richard Quandt. Passed.

Richard Quandt made a motion to approve the June Treasurer's Report. 2nd by Terry Koebernick. Passed.

Pat Glover made a motion to approve the June Financial Secretary's Report. 2nd by Laverne Koebernick. Passed.

Laverne Koebernick made a motion to approve the June Individual Financial Reports. 2nd by Richard Quandt. Passed.

Education: Rally Sunday will be August 18. We will invite all kids from VBS and Sunday school to join us for snacks, games, and prizes as we kick off the new year of Sunday School. About 30 attended our teacher and VBS volunteer appreciation meal. We are also looking for people to volunteer to teach year 1 or 2 for confirmation students. If you are interested, please talk to a Board of Education member or one of the pastors. Finally, if anyone wants to join Katie at the LCEF Lunch and Learn, it's going to be in Norfolk on August 20th - it's a great opportunity to hear about the things LCEF offers to the churches of Nebraska.

Trustees: Waiting for bids to finish the rain gutters. Waiting for bids on trimming the trees.

Elders: Elders were reminded to make sure banners from Baptisms are given to the families. Communion practices were discussed. According to the Lutheran Confessions every Worship Service should include Holy Communion. Elders are to visit with members of the congregation for feedback on the subject and Pastor Awe will, with bible studies and sermons, educate the people on Lutheran beliefs and practices regarding the Sacrament of the Altar. Clara Woten, Don Esch and Laverne Koebernick have volunteered to fill in while Angie is on vacation. Terry Koebernick will follow up with Angie and the volunteers to work out days and times coverage is needed. This info will be published in Sunday bulletins. Elders recommend that the roll-down screen and projector be moved into the gym. They further recommend that its replacement with 70" LED screens be postponed until more information can be gathered to determine the need and cost-effectiveness. The LCMS website will have a Facebook page to keep up to date on the Congo Medical Mission that Pastor Awe is leading. Pastor Awe returns July 30. Pulpit coverage will be Pastors Witte and Flo.

Stewardship: Board reviewed the June 2019 Financial Secretary report, bank statement and budget reports, and all looked good. Board recognized the organization and transparency Pat Glover has brought to our finances – truly appreciated! Board reviewed the Memorial committee activity and all looked good. The Time and Talent Sheets will be coming out in the fall. We got a \$900.00 rebate on the two new furnaces. Our next regular meeting will be Thursday August 8 @ 4pm.

Memorial Committee: No report.

Missions: No report.

Hispanic Ministry Committee: No report.

Friendship Committee: We helped with the installation of Pastor Flo. For the dinner, we did the table decorations and helped with furnishing food. We delivered the large print Portals of Prayer to our elder care.

President's Report: Thank you for coming. Lots of work to be done and we are moving right along with projects.

Pastor's Report: Due to the absence of Pastor Awe and Pastor Witte, Pastor Flo gave the Pastor's report. Thank you for the wonderful installation dinner. My family really appreciated all the work that everyone put into that day. We are making progress with the Hispanic Ministry. Please keep us in your prayers. Pastor Flo will be in Laurel on the 21st and Pastor Witte will be doing the worship service on that Sunday. Thank you to everyone that helped with the move and the items for the pantry shower. All was greatly appreciated.

Old Business: The work on the cold air returns in the rooms and east hall wing will begin in about 2 weeks. The removal of the old tile and installation of the new tile in the east side of the Ed. Bldg. will start on July 17th. We will be needing help and we should start working about 6:30 p.m.

New Business: The security keys and intercom system will be tabled till next month. Still working on bids. The new doors are here and there will be 6 keys made. The keys will be made the same. This is a master key. Some time next week the new doors will be installed. The cost of the installation will be about \$140.00 per door. The sound system is in the works. The equipment has been ordered. So far, this equipment comes to \$893.00. The new order that was placed will come to around \$7,000.00. Another \$2,000.00 was to be on the bill, but this bill will have to be checked to see if the items have been processed. Katie has been in contact with a person from Omaha that will be able to check out the organ. He has already said that Baldwin has gone out of business, but he will still look at the organ. His fee will be \$300.00 for the first hour and this will include minor repairs. Another expense that would come out of the memorial fund would be about \$500.00 for a cage that will go around the projection screen that will be moved from the sanctuary to the gym. Another added item to the new sound system, would be to add 2-70-inch TV's up front in the Sanctuary and 1 smaller TV added to the front of the balcony. This smaller TV would be used for the Pastors. These TV's would run about \$2,500.00. The 3 TV's have been put on hold for more discussion. The sign on 2nd Ave. has letters that are breaking and need to be replaced. Robert Billiar made a motion to have Ace Sign replace the letters. 2nd by Terry Koebernick. Passed. The landscaping under the new sign needs to have 4 bushes and possibly 2 more bushes around the garage. Richard Quandt made a motion to have Robert Billiar check into getting bushes from Bloomers. 2nd by Laverne Koebernick. Passed. There has been an abandoned van in the parking lot. The ruling on unauthorized vehicles on the property will be to have them removed in 24 hours or be towed. Pastor Flo will put another notice on the van written in Spanish, to see if someone will move it.
